



MRS Pre-ETS Service Terms

Competitive Integrated Employment (CIE)

Work that is performed on a full-time or part-time basis

Job Exploration Counseling

This service category is intended to provide counseling and guidance to help students explore career options.

Work-based Learning Experiences

Work-based learning is an educational approach that uses the workplace or real work to provide students with the knowledge and skills that will help them connect school experiences to real-life work activities and future career opportunities.

Workplace Readiness Training

These services are designed to develop independent living and social skills necessary for a student to be successful in employment.

Instruction in Self-Advocacy

Self-Advocacy instruction provides student with opportunities to learn about rights, responsibilities and how to request accommodations, services or supports students may need to successfully complete the transition from secondary to post-secondary education and/or employment.

Potentially eligible

A potentially eligible student is a student who meets the criteria as a student with a disability (SWD) and in need of Pre-ETS, but has not applied, or been determined eligible for VR services.

Eligible student

A student who meets the criteria as a SWD and has applied and been determined eligible for individual VR services.
